London saw a sunny and a busy day. As well as the introduction to ERA Kairos and an update on what's coming, delegates heard from Lloyd's of London and Chartis Research. In a highly anticipated presentation, Alex Noorbaccus of Lloyd's explained to the group how the organisation implemented its upgrade to ERA Kairos.

Just as eagerly awaited was Peyman Mestchian of Chartis Research. The risk technology specialist reported on the need for a shift in the understanding of GRC management and stressed that the personalisation of systems was key: something ERA Kairos is specifically designed to offer. "Integrated risk management is a global GRC driver," Mestchian said, adding that "lack of personalisation has been a key barrier to success".





Now that ERA Kairos is available and can be personalised for each user, this barrier has been lifted, the end-user experience has advanced significantly and companies are finding ever more ways to make successful compliance part of the every-day.

The tour bus continued to Sydney where one participant noted that the presentations offered the opportunity to refresh their usage of their existing ERA packages, giving “the chance to see how other users are implementing the product, particularly seeing functionality which we may have forgotten about”. Interactive Q&A also gave guests an “understanding of some new ERA functionality and how different users have tailored it to meet their personal requirements”.
